### **CELL PHONE POLICY**

As a primary school we prefer children to **not have cell phones at school**. Communication between parents and children should ensure that children know who is fetching them after school etc. We acknowledge, however, that in some cases it may be necessary for children to bring a phone to school. In such cases the following rules apply:

1. Children bring phones to school at their own risk. While it is in their possession, they are solely responsible for the phone. Phones may not be left in bags.
2. Parents must know that the phone is at school and write a note to the class teacher.
3. Children must hand their phone to the class teacher first thing in the morning.
4. If a child takes their phone to a sports match, they must hand it to the sports coach for safe keeping.
5. The school does not accept any responsibility for phones that are not handed in for safe keeping.
