UNIFORM

Summer uniform is now compulsory. Please ensure that children have the correct uniform and that **all items are clearly marked**. Children who are wearing their sports clothes as uniform may not wear brightly coloured takkies, or very bright/ luminous laces.

WATER CRISIS

Remember to do everything you can to save water!

Children should all bring a bottle of drinking water from home every day.

Children may wear sports clothes to school on the days they have P.E or extra mural sport in the afternoon. This is to try and minimize laundry at home, bearing in mind that laundry should only be done when you have a full load. If children wear sports clothes please ensure that they wear white takkies.

Also be aware that City of Cape Town is talking about cutting off water supply in different areas as they did with load shedding. This could be done without warning so families are being advised to have at least 5 litres of emergency drinking water available at home at all times.

JANUARY CAMPS

Grade 5 and Grade 7 camps have been booked for January next year. Parents were informed about these camps at the Meet The Teacher meeting at the beginning of this year. The cost of the Grade 5 camp is R900 and the cost of the Grade 7 High Africa camp is R1800. Parents are strongly encouraged to pay for these camps in instalments at the end of every month (September – December) so that by January, you have already paid.
